Materials

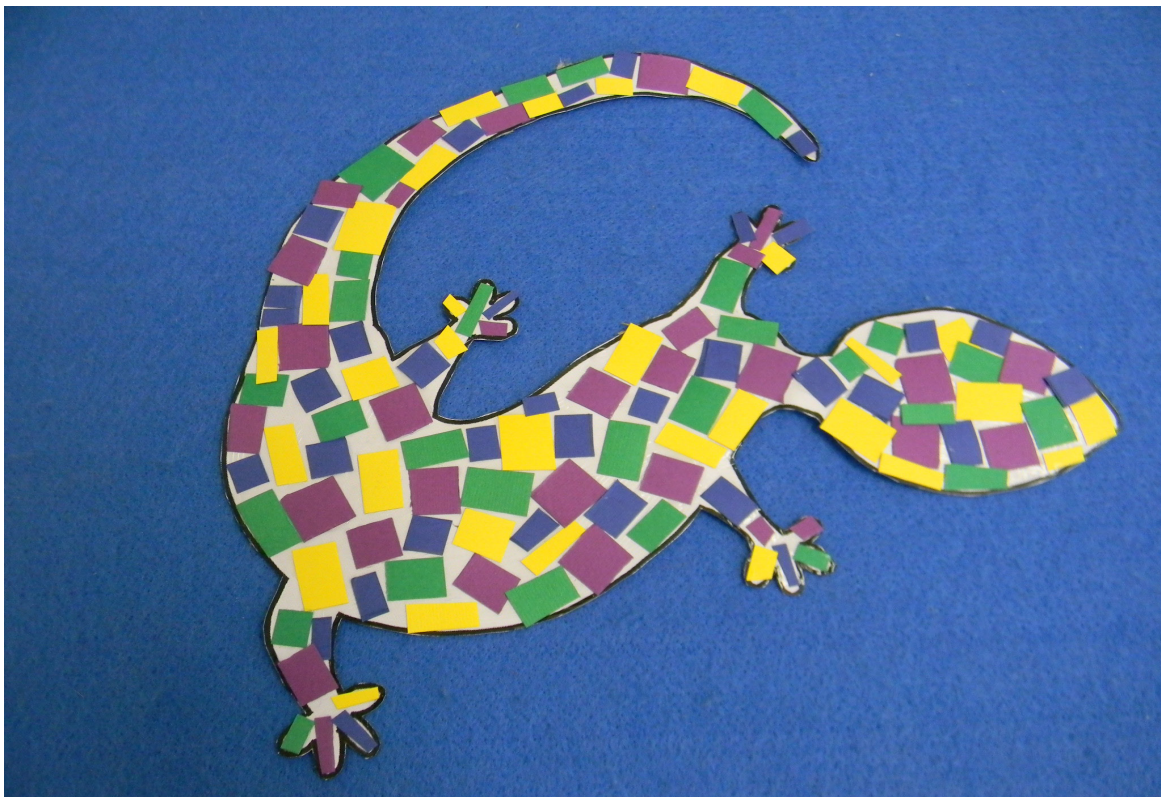
Chameleon template
Several colours of tissue paper/construction paper
Glue
Markers

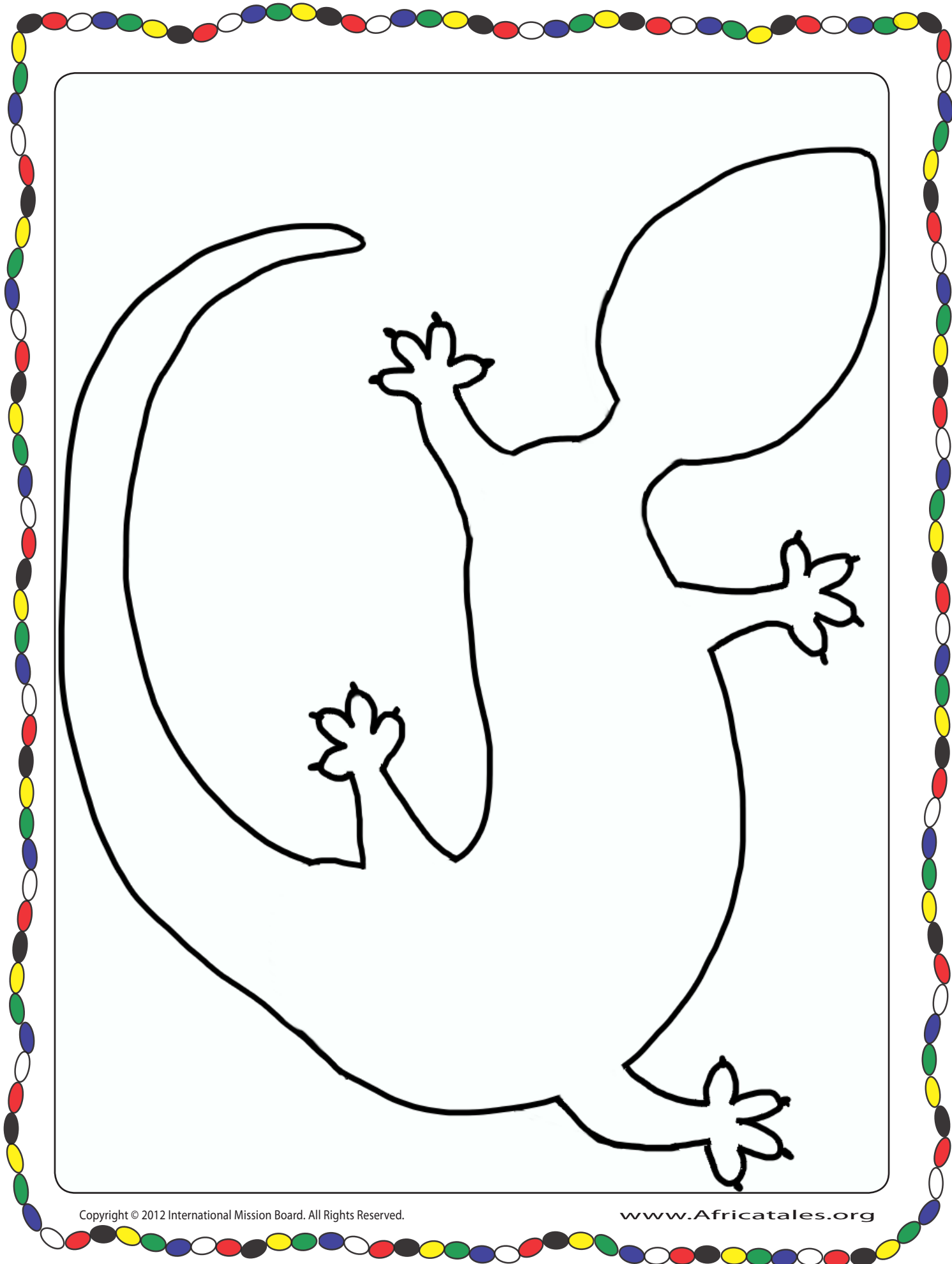
Prep Work

Cut tissue/construction paper into small pieces
If your children are too young to use scissors, you can also go ahead and cut out the template ahead of time.

Instructions

1. Decorate with bits of paper until the template is covered in colour.
2. Draw on eyes







CLAP GAME

Africa

Not Africa

Polar bear; school bus; tiger; taco; Mississippi River; alligator; caribou; Statue of Liberty; kangaroo; prairie dog; electric guitar; etc.

Chameleon; river; corn; donkey cart; dirt road; cows; hut; camel; farm; banana; drum; etc.
