

SALVATION BEADS

Have each child make a necklace (or bracelet, if preferred) using the salvation story as a pattern. Have each of them learn what the colors mean. Black: Sin; Red: Blood of Christ; White: Washed white as snow; Blue: Waters of baptism; Green: Growing in Christ; Yellow: Streets of Heaven. Let them practice telling the story until they feel ready to share it with their friends.

SAMBURU BEADS

Materials

Regular-sized paper plate (not Styrofoam)
Colored construction paper cut into small squares (about ½ inch)
Glue
Scissors

Instructions

1. Remove the inner circle of the plate, and also a small section of the rim—about 4 inches. This will be the base of the necklace, so make sure the piece you remove is not too big, or it will fall off! You should be left with a “C” shape.
2. Glue the piece you removed from the rim to the bottom of the “C” opposite the opening.
3. Glue the paper beads around the necklace and allow to dry.
